 - Other Buildings:** Hotel Park Inn, Discount Store, Restaurant, Book Off, 24 hour Meal Shop, Gyudon Yoshinoya, Coin Laundry, Jonathan's (Restaurant), Bread Shop, Noodle Shop, Dotor, Used Book Store, Liquor, Theater Sun-Mall, M's Hotel, Hanazono Clinic, AM/PM, Discount Store, Dotor, Furniture Store, Gas Station (Jomo), Dental Office, Sun Music, Yotsuya Kumin Center and Yotsuya Library (7F), Curry, and JTB.
- Streets:** Yasukuni Avenue, Hanazono - Dori, and Shinjuku Avenue.
- Compass Rose:** Located in the top left corner, indicating North (N), South (S), East (E), and West (W).
